Please note Netball has now changed from a Tuesday to a Thursday after school.

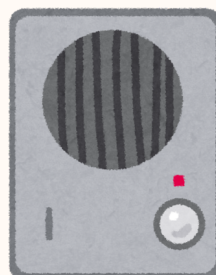

### Important Health Information: Cystic Fibrosis in Our School Community

We would like to make our school community aware that we have a child in school with Cystic Fibrosis (CF). Cystic Fibrosis does not pose any risk to the general public. However, children and adults who also have CF can be at risk if they come into close contact with another person living with the condition.

According to NHS-supported guidance, people with CF are vulnerable to bacteria that are usually harmless to others, and these can be passed between individuals with the condition through close contact or shared environments. This is known as cross-infection, and it can lead to serious health complications for those affected. For this reason, people with CF are advised to avoid direct contact with others who have CF to protect their long-term health.

What we need from visitors:

If you, your child, or another visitor to the school has Cystic Fibrosis, please let us know before visiting. This helps us ensure everyone's safety by preventing any risk of cross-infection.

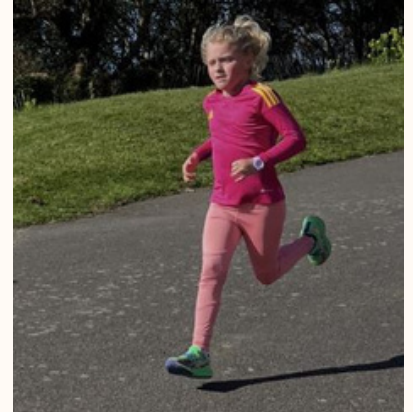


### Operation Encompass
