Places are limited, but a waitlist will be available if there is high interest. To book a place, please sign up via your MCAS App; live from 12pm today I look forward to seeing you.

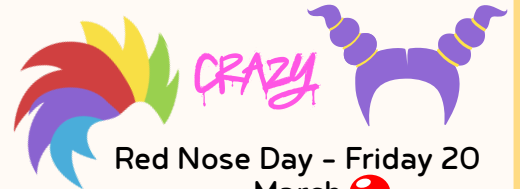
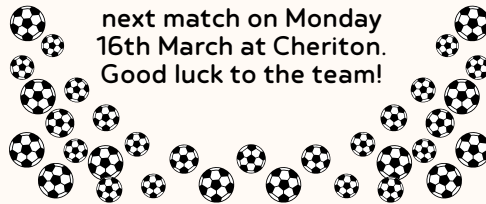

Inside Out Day - Friday 27th March

This term, across the school the children will be learning about the Zones of Regulation, a framework that helps them recognise and manage their emotions. The Zones use four colours to represent different feelings and levels of alertness, giving pupils simple tools to understand their emotional state and choose helpful strategies. On Inside Out Day, students are invited to come to school dressed in a way that represents how they feel or how they understand emotions. Parents and carers might like to ask their children which Zone they've been in today and what strategies they are learning to use. Let's keep the conversation going at home as well as in school!
