Why the Good Samaritan is Such an Important Story for Our
School

At All Souls' Church of England Primary School, we believe
that every child is wonderfully made by God and that
together we can make a positive difference in the lives of
others. This is why the story of the Good Samaritan is such an
important one for our school community.

In the parable, Jesus tells of a man who is hurt and left in need
on the roadside. Several people pass by without helping, but a
Samaritan, someone who would not normally have been
expected to stop, shows kindness, compassion and courage.
He puts the needs of another person before his own and goes
out of his way to help.

This story reminds us that being a good neighbour is not
about who someone is, where they come from, or whether
they are our friend. It is about showing love, kindness and
respect to everyone. These are values we encourage every
day at All Souls', whether children are supporting a classmate,
welcoming someone new, including others in their games, or
helping someone who is feeling worried or upset.

The Good Samaritan teaches us that even small acts of
kindness can have a big impact. By choosing to care for one
another, we help to create a school where everyone feels safe,
valued and loved. In doing so, we live out our school vision.

Through this story, children learn that they can make a
difference in their community by showing compassion,
friendship and service to others, just as Jesus taught.

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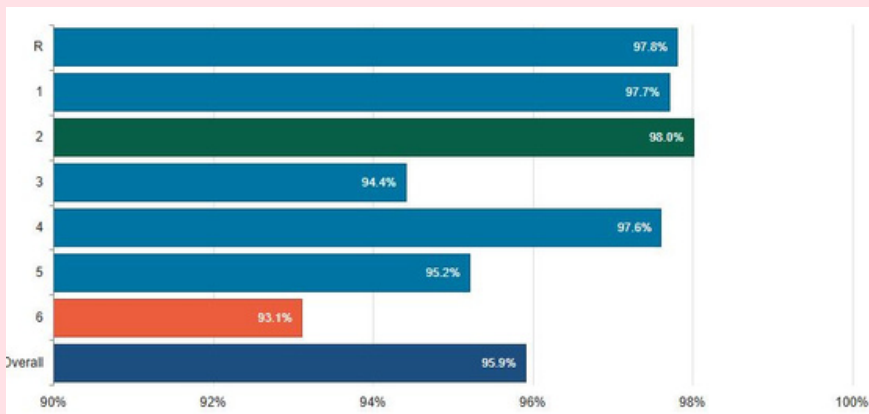

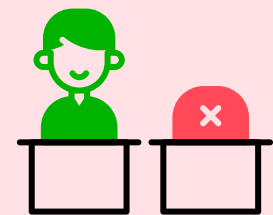

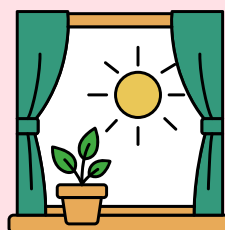

What does persistent absence mean?

A child is classed as persistently absent when they miss 10% or more of their school sessions. This may be due to a combination of illnesses, appointments, holidays, or other absences. Even when each absence seems small on its own, they can quickly add up and have a significant impact on a child's learning, friendships, confidence, and progress in school. Regular attendance helps children to build strong routines, develop positive relationships, and achieve their full potential.



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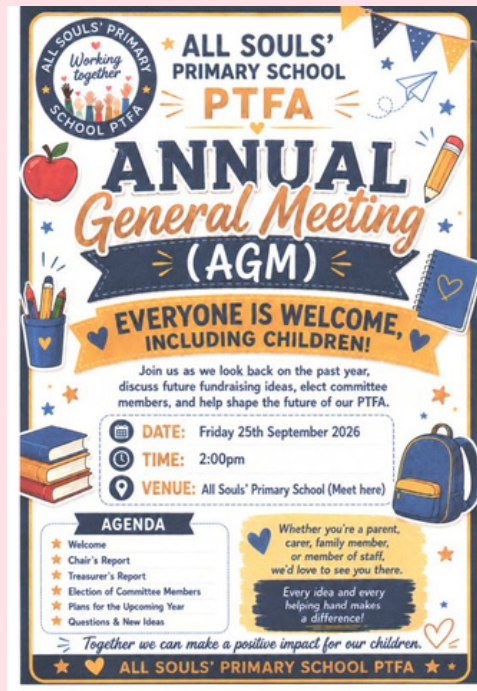

Election of Parent Governors

I am writing to invite you to consider standing for election as a parent governor at our school.

Together with the Headteacher, the Local Governing Body has responsibility for the Leadership of the school. Governors are involved in three core responsibilities:

1. Consider where the school can improve and develop.
2. Challenge the school to deliver its planned outcomes.
3. Make sure the school's money gets the best education for the pupils.

As a Church School we also consider how our Christian ethos plays a role in our work and also forms part of our meetings.

You will need some time to offer during the day and in the evening and a willingness to learn. Training is available which is mainly online. However, the main thing you need is a passion for making a real difference to our school community.

If you are interested in applying, please provide a short statement about what you think you could bring to the role. **This shouldn't be any more than 100 words and can be emailed or dropped into the school office. The attached form will also need to be filled in alongside the statement.** The statement should only include biographical information, your reasons for wanting to be a parent governor and the skills and expertise you believe you can bring to our Local Governing Body.

Once we receive your nomination, you will be invited to attend a meeting to discuss the position further and find out more about what we do.

If the number of nominations received is equal, or less than, the number of vacancies, the nominees will automatically be elected as parent governor. If, however, there are more nominations than vacancies, an election will be held, and copies of the personal statements will be sent to all parents. One week will be allowed for the return of ballot papers. Each parent will have one vote for each vacancy, no matter how many children he or she has at the school.

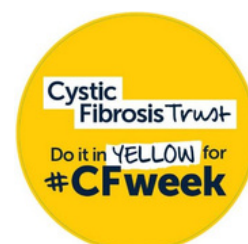

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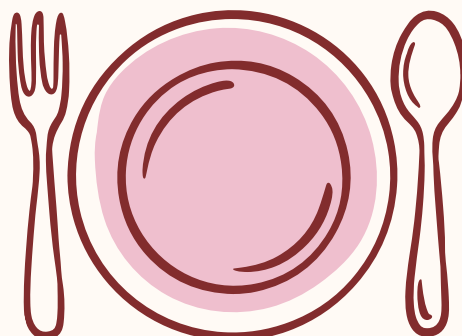
