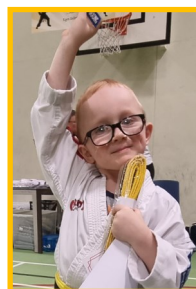

Time to reflect

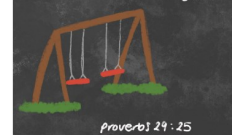
We are still looking at how the proverbs can support us in our everyday life. This week we have discussed these proverbs-
