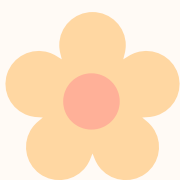

## Changes to support for families with children eligible for Free School Meals

We are writing to let you know about an important change to the support available to families with children who are eligible for free school meals during school holidays.

### End of supermarket vouchers funded by the Household Support Fund (HSF)

In recent years, families of children eligible for free school meals have received supermarket vouchers during school holidays. These vouchers were funded by the Government's Household Support Fund (HSF).

The HSF ended on 31 March 2026. As a result, no further supermarket vouchers will be issued for school holiday periods after Easter 2026.

Easter 2026 vouchers, where issued, remain live and can still be redeemed if families have not yet used them. Please ensure that these are downloaded fully as soon as possible.

We understand that this change may be difficult for families.

### Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme

Support continues to be available through the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme.

The HAF Programme provides children aged 4 to 16 who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals with:

- Free holiday activities and experiences
- A healthy meal on the days they attend.

HAF activities run during the Easter, summer and Christmas school holidays. The council is also proposing to complement this existing support through the use of Crisis and Resilience Fund (CRF) monies, with appropriate governance arrangements currently being progressed.

## Kent Test

For children starting secondary school in September 2027

If your child is currently in Year 5, and you intend to apply to a Kent Grammar school, register online at [kent.gov.uk/kenttest](http://kent.gov.uk/kenttest)

Registration opens on 1 June 2026 and closes at midnight on 1 July 2026

### Who is the Kent Test for?

The Kent Test is for children who wish to apply for a Kent Grammar school place for September 2027 and are either resident in the UK or are the children of UK Service Personnel / other Crown Servants returning to the UK. A list of Kent Grammar schools can be found [here](#). Schools in Medway, Bexley and Bromley are outside the Kent Local Authority area. If you live outside Kent, please consider carefully before registering whether your child can attend the testing session in Kent, and how they would travel to school if they were offered a school place in Kent.

### How do I register for the Kent Test?

Go to [kent.gov.uk/kenttest](http://kent.gov.uk/kenttest) and create an online account for yourself as parent/guardian. Add your child's details to your account to start the registration process. When you have completed and submitted your registration you should get a confirmation email. If you do not, the registration may not have been completed correctly. (Tip: Please check your junk/spam folder for the email before contacting us!)

### What if my child has access requirements?

If your child has a disability or SEN which will affect their access to testing, you should discuss this with their primary school before registering them, as the school will need to apply for any necessary access arrangements. Requests will not be accepted after 1 July 2026.

### What happens after I register?

If your child attends a school outside Kent, we will email you details of their test centre by the end of August. Let us know if after registration you move house, change your email address or your child changes primary school. Otherwise, their test papers may go to the wrong place, or you may not get their results.

### How do I apply for a Kent Grammar school?

You apply by naming the school as a preference on your Local Authority's secondary application form.

### If my child is assessed suitable for grammar school by the Kent Test, will I automatically be offered a grammar school place?

No, a Kent Grammar school assessment does not guarantee your child a place in a Kent Grammar school. Grammar schools are often oversubscribed, meaning more children apply than the school has room for. Oversubscribed schools use their admission criteria to rank applicants in priority order, so it's important to check the admission criteria for schools you are interested in. A Kent Grammar school can only consider your child for a place if you have named it on your application and your child has been tested and assessed suitable for admission. If your child is not offered a place at the school, you can appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and may be able to add them to the school's waiting list.

### Key dates

<b>Monday 1 June 2026</b>	Registration opens at <a href="http://kent.gov.uk/kenttest">kent.gov.uk/kenttest</a> . You will receive a confirmation email when registration is complete.
<b>Wednesday 1 July 2026</b>	Registration closes at midnight. If your child attends a school outside Kent, you will receive an email by the end of August with your Allocated Test Centre.
<b>Thursday 10 September 2026</b>	Children who attend a Kent primary school sit the test in their school.
<b>Saturday 12 September 2026 / Sunday 13 September 2026</b>	Children who attend primary schools outside Kent or are Educated at Home sit the test in a Test Centre.
<b>Thursday 15 October 2026</b>	Kent Test Decisions emails are sent after 4pm to the email address used to register the child.

If you apply online, do not complete any other form of registration. Keep your login details safe and use the email address you registered from for all communication with the team.

## Dover Grammar School for Girls

Dear Parent/Carer

You will soon be asked to choose a secondary school for your child. To help you with your decision we have arranged an Open Evening on Thursday, 11<sup>th</sup> June 2026 at 5.30pm (which includes a tour of the school) as well as additional tours and a short presentation from the Headteacher, on Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup>, Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> and Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026 at 9.30am. The Headteacher will be available at all of the tour sessions to answer any questions you may have.

Booking is not necessary for the Open Evening, however, as the additional tours take place during working school days, these will need to be booked in advance. Bookings for the tours are limited to 4 people which includes your child and can be made by clicking this link: [Dover Grammar School for Girls Open Day Tours 2026 - Fill out form](#)

It is possible to apply for a place at DGGS either through our own procedure, the Dover Assessment Test, or that of the Kent Test. Your daughter may take the Dover Assessment Test, the Kent Test or both, however, she only needs to pass one of the tests. You need to register your daughter to take the Kent Test by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026, and the Dover Assessment Test by Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Assessment decisions will then be sent to you by Kent County Council, Secondary Admissions and the school on Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> October 2026. In order to be considered for a place at Dover Grammar School for Girls, you must then name the school on the Secondary Common Application Form (SCAF) which must be submitted to Kent Secondary Admissions by Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2026.

To register for the Dover Assessment Test please scan the QR code below or click the link: <https://dgsa.applica.com/entranceexam>

Complete the Assessment Registration form in full and submit. (The Shepway test will be held on the same day; therefore, anyone living in the Folkestone area would need to choose which entrance test to take).



If you have difficulty completing the form, your primary school may be able to assist you.

We shall be holding Dover entrance tests on the morning of **Saturday, 12<sup>th</sup> September 2026**. Please ensure that you have registered your daughter to take the test before **Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.
