

Compound words

- Compound means ‘a thing that is composed of two or more separate elements’.
- A compound word is a word made up of two or more other words.
For example: classroom = class + room (a room in which a class is taught)

- Adjectives give more information about a noun.

They could give information on:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • quantity (the number of items) e.g. <i>several</i> • quality (an opinion on the noun) e.g. <i>fantastic</i> • size e.g. <i>large</i> • age e.g. <i>old</i> • shape e.g. <i>round</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • colour e.g. <i>blue</i> • origin or nationality e.g. <i>English</i> or <i>Victorian</i> • material (what it is made of) e.g. <i>cotton</i> • mood (of a person or animal) e.g. <i>happy</i>
