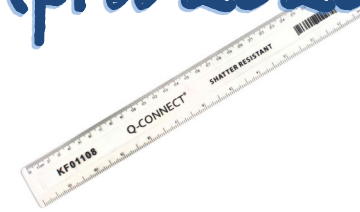

Draw the object in your books and write your maths sentence E.G:



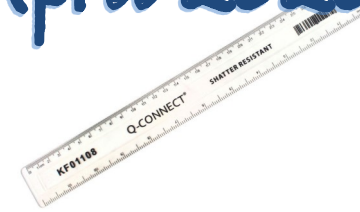
The leaf is 8 cubes long.

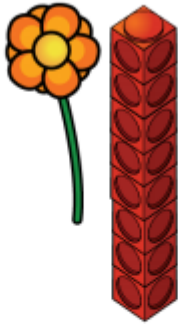

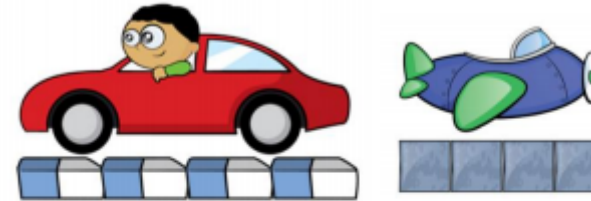
