Welcome to the last week of lockdown! It is also the last week of basing our learning on Potions and Harry Potter.

This week, you will be retelling Chapter 16, 'Through the Trap Door,' in your own words. Don't forget to watch the videos that go with these sessions to help you with your learning. We are really looking forward to seeing your final piece of writing for this topic.

Monday 1st March 2021

Today is all about Chapter 17, The Man with Two Faces. To answer the following questions, make sure you have read or listened to the chapter. Answer the questions using full sentences and include as much detail as you can, using evidence from the text.



Tuesday 2nd March 2021:

Today, you are going to focus on planning your story. You are retelling the events that took place when Ron, Hermione and Harry went through the trap door and were faced with a number of challenges to solve.

You will need to use the story mountain to help plan the build-up, the problem, and the resolution. The plan should be clear and contain as much detail as possible. There is a video, planning sheet and story mountain to go with today's lesson.



Wednesday 3rd March 2021

Ron gritted his teeth and stepped carefully over the dog's legs. He bent and pulled the ring of the trapdoor, which swung up and open. He could not see what lay beneath. Without hesitation, they each dropped down fearlessly into the darkness, landing on something soft.



Today, you are going to start writing your story. You only need to focus on the build-up today, making sure you use your plan to guide you. Try to use exciting vocabulary and

make sure you have included punctuation within your sentences.

Focus on extending your sentences using subordinate clauses and conjunctions.

Thursday 4th March 2021

It's now time to write the problems in your story. What situations do Harry, Ron and Hermione find themselves in? What obstacles do they need to overcome in each of the rooms they enter? There are actually several problems in this chapter. It is important to show the characters reactions to the events taking place around them. Using the senses, such as sight and sound, describe how each is feeling and what can be seen in each setting (room).

Focus on using similes and alliteration in your description.

Friday 5th March 2021

Today, you need to write the resolution to your story. How is the problem resolved? You are writing up to the end of chapter 16, where Harry moves through the black flames into the final chamber.



Focus on using a range of sentence and word types.

As a challenge, you may want to continue the story and write an alternative ending. There is a separate set of instructions and planning sheet for this should you decide to do this.
