<p><u>Build Up</u></p> <p>What is going to happen in your story?</p> <p>Hermione, Ron and Harry feature in this chapter and are faced with a number of challenges they have to pass.</p>	
<p><u>Problem</u></p> <p>What is the main problem or obstacle that the characters face?</p> <p>There are a number of challenges Harry, Hermione and Ron have to face. What are they? Where do they take place?</p>	
<p><u>Resolution</u></p> <p>How do the characters deal with the problems?</p> <p>How do they solve them and move on to the next room?</p>	
<p><u>Ending</u></p> <p>What happens to the characters?</p> <p><i>As a challenge, you could add an unexpected twist at the end.</i></p> <p>Stop at the end of chapter 16, as Harry passes through the black flames into the last chamber.</p>
