LO: To write the middle of an adventure story.

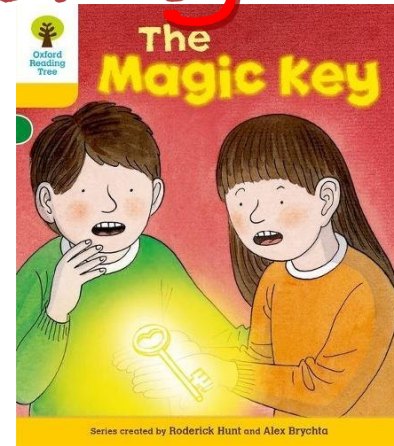
How did your story beginning go yesterday Amazing Authors?

Amazing Adventure Author's Steps to Success!

- correct punctuation—capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, commas, exclamation marks
- good sentence structure—read your work out loud, does it make sense?
- interesting adjectives—make sure your reader is gripped!
- check your spellings—have you used your sounds to help you?
