# Online safety @ All Souls'

Children will learn about responsible use of technology through the book, 'Websters Manners'. They will know how to be kind and careful when using devices and to tell an adult if something worrying happens when using technology. They will also be able to talk about good and bad choices in real life and the impact of technology on their health, wellbeing and lifestyle.

Children's learning will focus initially on the text, 'Chicken Clicking'. Described as the Little Red Riding Hood tale for the internet age, the story will teach children how to stay safe online. Children will use their VIPERS reading skills to discover the meaning of the text. They will know who to tell if they see something unexpected or that worries them online, they will know how to recognise age appropriate websites and how to follow sensible online safety rules. They will also know how to handle technology safely and responsibly.

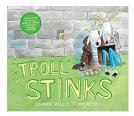

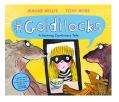

Children will then be introduced to the text, 'The Technology Tail: A Digital Footprint Story'. Children will know the importance of what they post online and how it can be seen, used and affects others. They will know what the term, 'digital footprint' means.

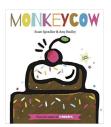
# Online safety @ All Souls'

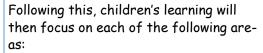
