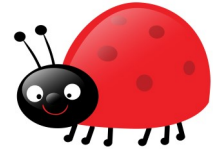


Ladybird Learning

This week we have continued with our curriculum theme of 'Dinosaur Roar!'. We have...

- Learned a little about the land during the time of the dinosaurs. At the beginning of the time of the dinosaurs, the land was one giant supercontinent called Pangaea. There were mountains, forests, swamps, lakes, deserts and many volcanoes. We went back in time, looking through our binoculars and wrote down the things we saw like slimy swamps, ferns and erupting volcanoes!
- We also discovered that T-Rex never met Stegosaurus because they lived during different times. Stegosaurus roamed the earth millions of years before T-Rex!
- Used our phonic skills to write labels/captions to explain how the plant eating dinosaurs protected themselves from being eaten by carnivorous dinosaurs.
- Explored addition in our maths sessions through 'combining two groups'. We used the double sided counters to represent the two groups on the 10 frames then counted all to find the total.
- Continued using and controlling a ball in our PE session. This week we used rackets and hockey sticks to control a ball along a path and then score a goal.
- Been sharing our 'dreams and goals' during our JIGSAW lesson this week. Goals are things that we would like to achieve or get better at. We know that achieving our goals won't be easy but, with practice, perseverance and not giving up, we know we can reach our goals.
