
09.06.23 Year 2 Maths — This week we have been using lots of new language about movement and turns. Try this fun task at home!

Jo is moving around a grid.




Draw arrows to show Jo's movement.

 - a) The ant turns a quarter turn left.






b) The ant turns a quarter turn anticlockwise.


