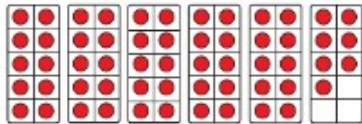

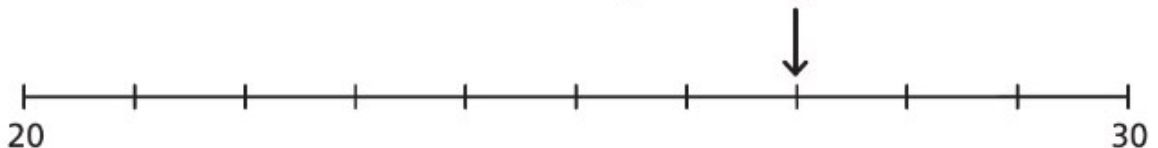
3 My number is made up of 5 tens and 7 ones.
