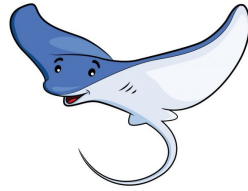


# Welcome to Years 3 and 4

Home learning will be sent out at the beginning of term. The home learning grid is also put on the website. Maths home learning will be added to the website each week. The maths home learning does not need to be stuck in the yellow books.

Reading books: We will be carrying out assessments for reading levels at the beginning of term. Please do not worry if your child brings home a book that you feel is the wrong level before then. The levels are given as a number range, not a colour as in Key Stage 1. The children have the opportunity to complete quizzes about the books they have read. These can be accessed from home too by following the link on our homework page on the website. Children can also complete bookmarks by reading at home. More information about this will be sent out shortly.

We are all looking forward to an exciting year, our first topic is 'Incredible Iron' so we will be finding out all magnets and forces, as well as reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. Our full topic grid will be on the website to see all our Wider Curriculum learning for this term.
