

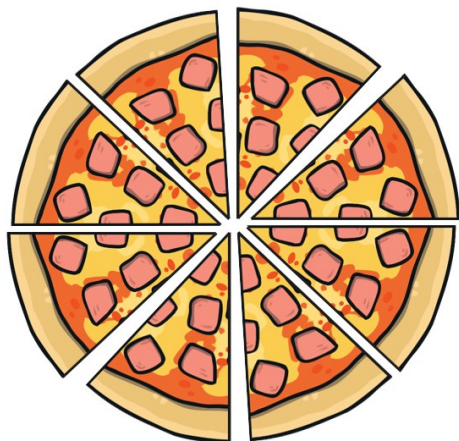
# Year 1 Maths Home Learning

Have go at the word problems below.

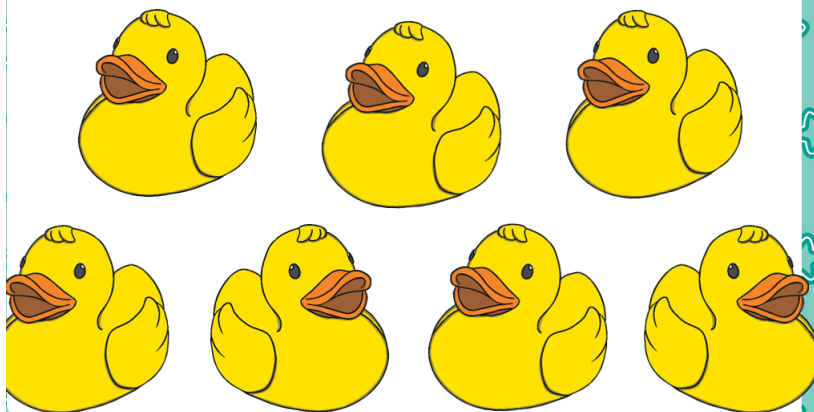
If you have 8 slices of pizza and 5 slices are eaten, how many slices would you have left?

If you have 3 rubber ducks and are given another 4, how many rubber ducks would you have?

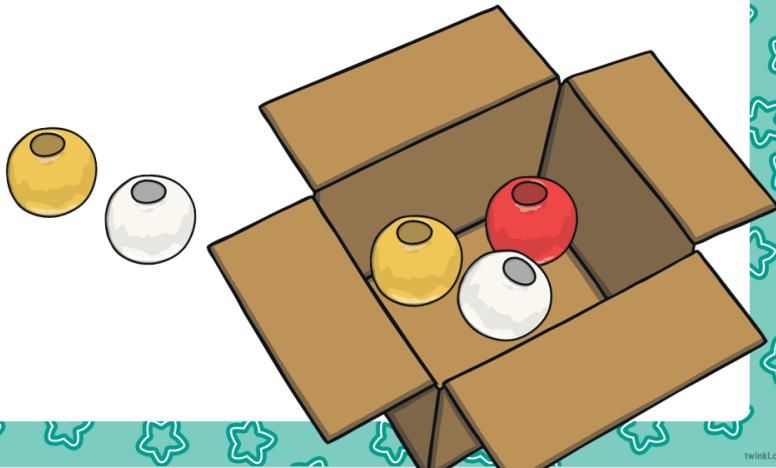


If you have 6 flowers and give 2 of them away, how many would you have left?



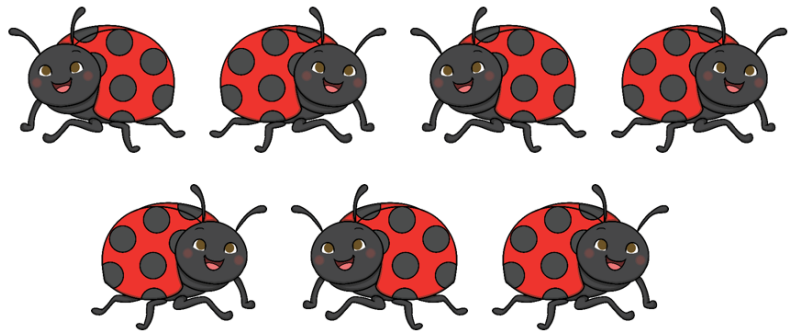
Write a number sentence to match the word problem.

If you find 2 wooden beads under the sofa and then find another 3 in a box, how many beads would you have?



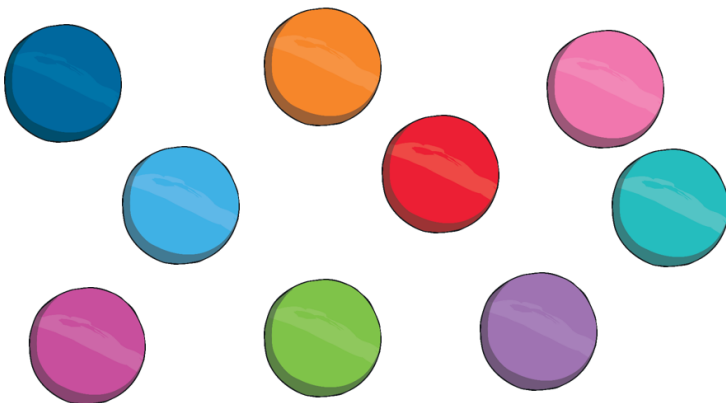
Write a number sentence to match the word problem.
