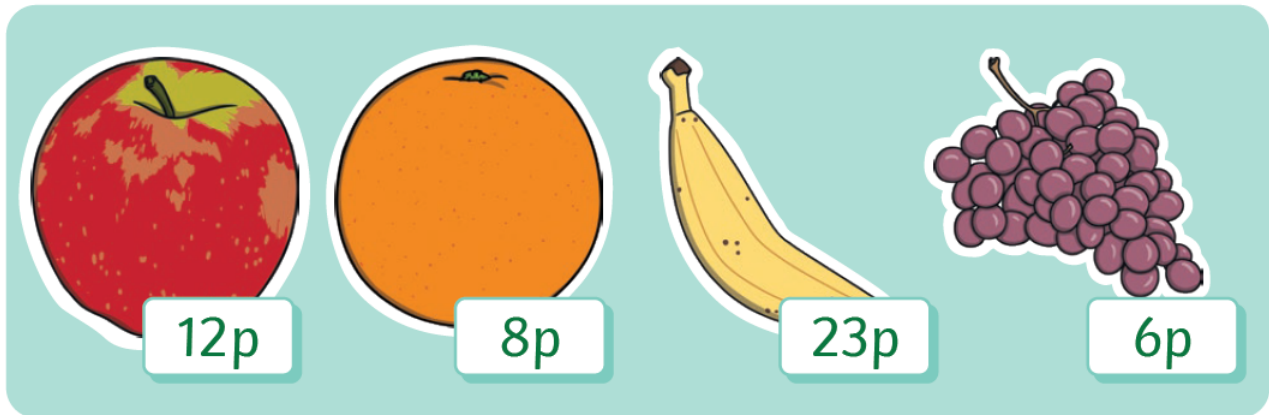


Calculating Cost

cost of an orange and grapes?

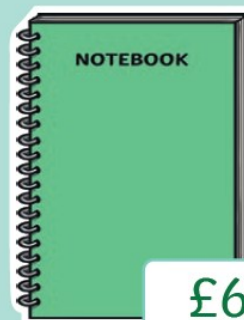

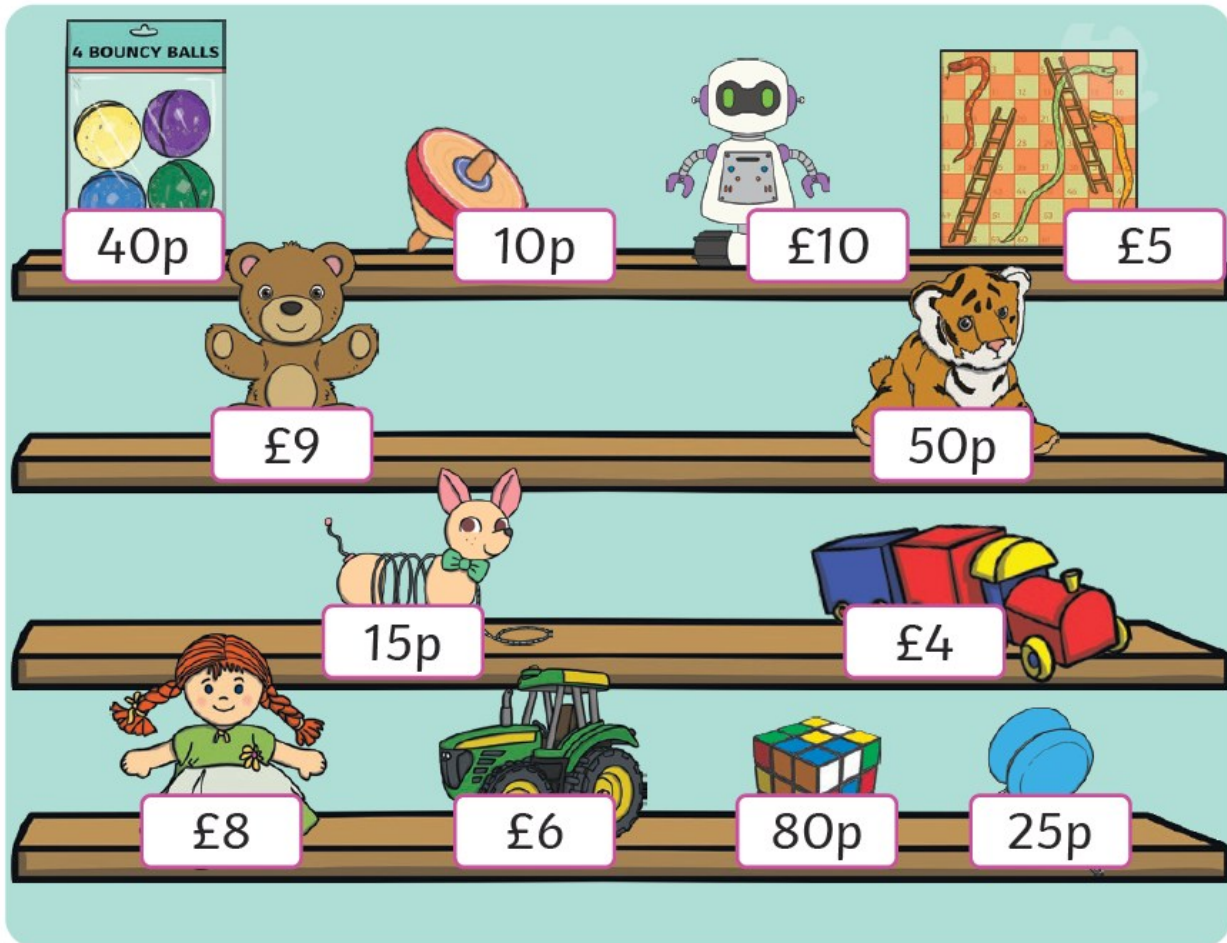
