Try solving the following word problems. Remember, think through the problem to decide if you need to add or subtract.

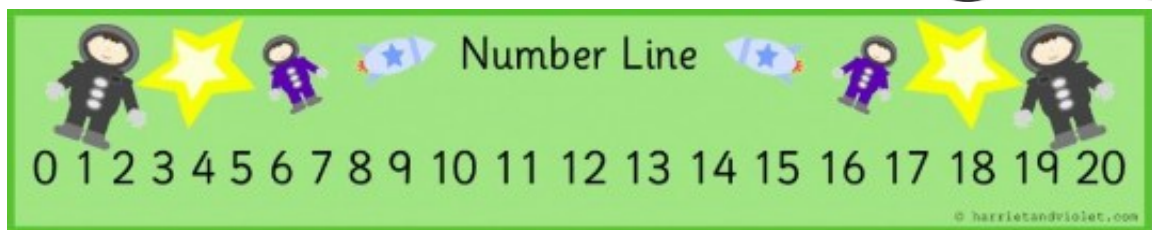
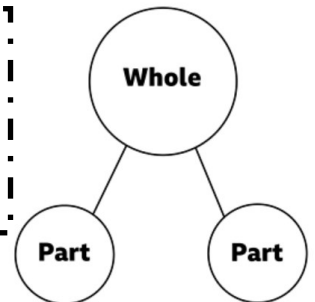

Use doubles and near-doubles knowledge.

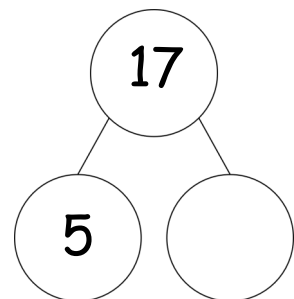


The first problem has been done for you...

If you have 17 slices of pizza and 5 are eaten, how many slices would you have left?

$$17 - 5 = 12$$

I know it will be subtraction because there will be fewer pizza slices after some are eaten.

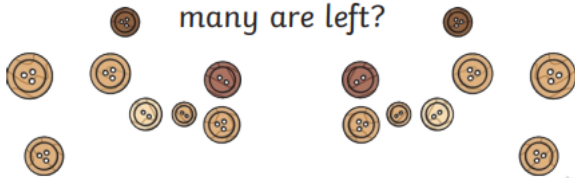
I know $7 - 5$ is 2, so $17 - 5$ must equal 12.

If you have 14 sweets and buy 3 more, how many sweets will you have?

If you have 16 buttons but lose 2 of them, how many are left?



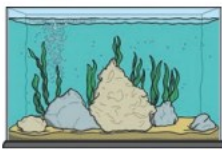
