

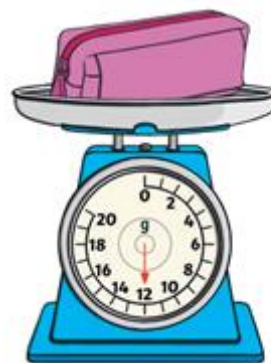
Year 2 Home Learning Measuring mass using grams
