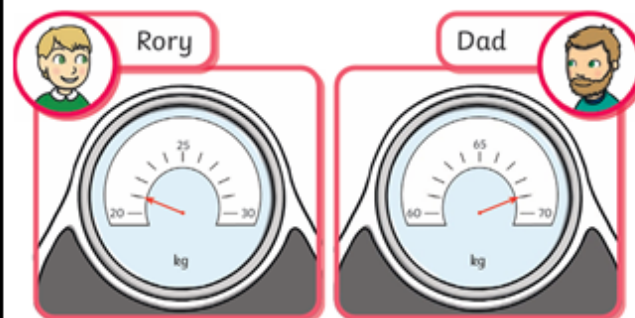


Find 2 things that you could measure in grams and 2 things you could measure in kilograms. Use the stem sentence to explain your reasoning.
