We have also partitioned larger numbers into groups of tens and ones, found one more/one less and used 'greater than' and 'less than' when comparing numbers to 100.

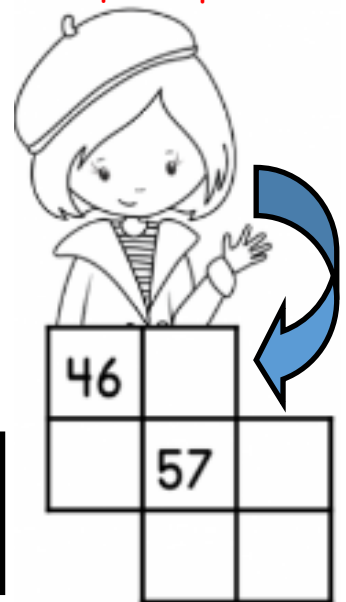

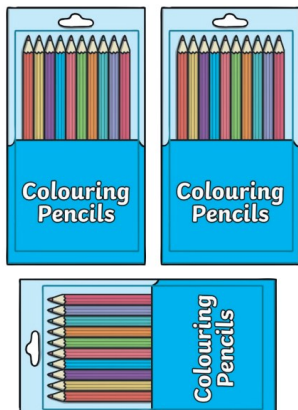

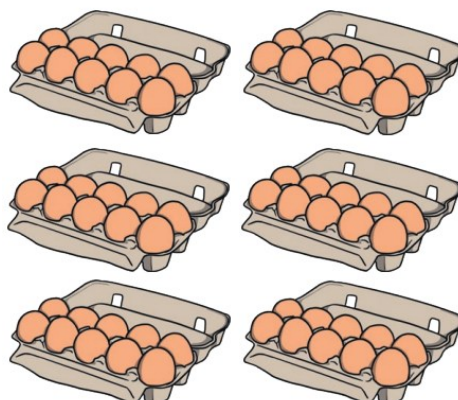

Find the groups of 10 to help you count each total.

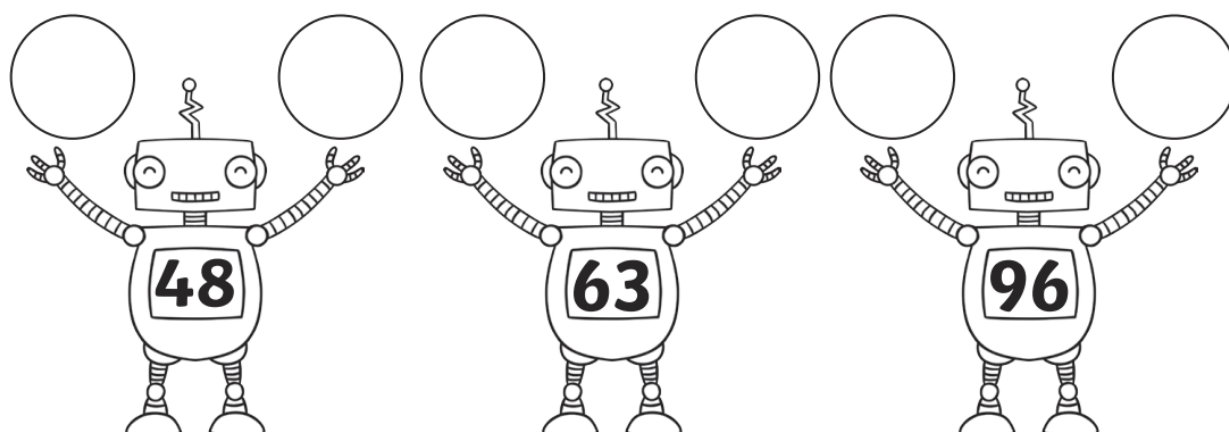
